

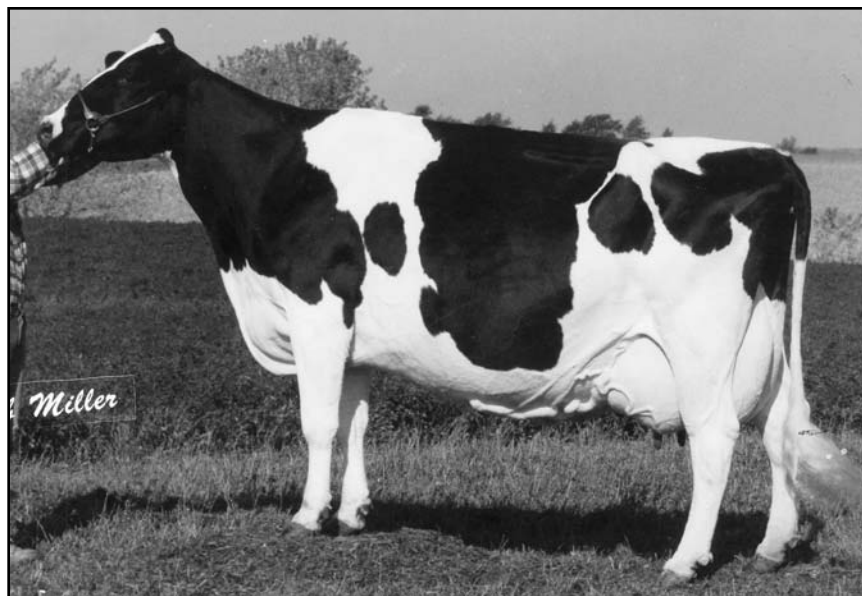
~ *C Glenridge Citation Roxy* ~

C Glenridge Citation Roxy's best daughter (Mil-R-Mor Roxette) was housed at Ridgedale as a 7-year old cow and made her best record here. Roxette came to Ridgedale when R. Peter Heffering sold her and her daughter (Astro Roxy) to Dreamstreet Holsteins. Dreamstreet ended up returning the pair to Heffering, and they were temporarily sent to Ridgedale for care. Both cows scored Excellent just one day after arriving at Ridgedale. The opportunity to work with these big, open-ribbed dairy cows on a daily basis initially sparked our interest in the Roxy family.

Hanover Hill Star Roxy was purchased from Hanover Hill Holsteins and Bond Haven in the 1987 Hanover Hill Dispersal. She was cataloged as lot 39A, a 10-month old daughter of Mil-R-Mor Roxette and sired by Hanover Hill Starbuck. She was originally named Bond Haven Star Roxy, but since R. Peter Heffering retained half interest in the calf, her prefix was changed to Hanover-Hill (perfectly legal in Canada, since Mr. Heffering was one of the breeding partners). A contingency of this sale was that Mil-R-Mor Roxette would never be bred back to Starbuck, thus making our Star Roxy, one of a kind.

Star Roxy was nominated All-American in 1987 as a Sr. Calf and again in 1988 as a Sr. Yearling. She has two full brothers in Al...Hanover Hill Raider EX- Extra and Hanover Hill Regency [proven at Taurus Service]. She has four (4) EX-94 offspring, three daughters and one son.

Eleven years later in Hanover Hill's 1998 Final Dispersal, Ridgedale purchased Bond-Haven Mark Roxy 5E-94 at 9 years of age. To date, Mark Roxy has left nine daughters (3 EX and 7 VG) and continues to breed on for us from another leg of the Roxy pedigree.
